Florida ranks third in the country for calls of suspected human trafficking to the National Human Trafficking Hotline. In 2021, over 2,000 victims were identified within the state. But as we know, human trafficking remains a hidden crime.

Human trafficking involves the use of force, fraud, or coercion to obtain some type of labor or commercial sex act. Human trafficking (or modern-day slavery) is the second largest global industry – behind illegal drug trafficking – and enslaves tens of millions of women, children, and men worldwide. The Florida Alliance to End Human Trafficking is a nonprofit organization that was created to provide funding, support, and assistance to the statewide effort to end human trafficking.


