Florida ranks third in the country for calls of suspected human trafficking to the National Human Trafficking Hotline. In 2024, over 2,000 victims were identified within the state. But as we know, human trafficking remains a hidden crime.

Human trafficking involves the use of force, fraud, or coercion to obtain some type of labor or commercial sex act. Human trafficking (or modern-day slavery) is the second largest global industry – behind illegal drug trafficking – and enslaves tens of millions of women, children, and men worldwide. It can happen in any community and victims can be any age, race, gender, or nationality.

The Florida Alliance to End Human Trafficking is a nonprofit organization that was created to provide funding, support, and assistance to the statewide effort to end human trafficking.

On Friday, May 15, 2026, the Florida Alliance to End Human Trafficking will host A Night of Hope and Healing at the Henry Morrison Flagler Museum which will recognize champions in the fight against exploitation and provide opportunities to be part of the solution and prevention of this horrific crime.

The emotional and powerful evening centered on stories of resilience and the ongoing fight to end human trafficking in Florida.



“Ending human trafficking isn’t a partisan issue—it’s a moral imperative. Tonight, we honor the bravery of survivors and the dedication of those who fight for them every day. Florida is stronger when we stand together against exploitation and work to ensure every person has the chance to live in freedom and dignity,” said Congressman Mike Haridopolos (FL-8), the event’s featured speaker.
